

ATTRACTING NEW BUSINESSES TO YORK COUNTY

In attracting new commercial enterprises to the County, the OED:

- Prepares customized proposals
- Identifies unique real estate and business partnering opportunities
- Furnishes information about local, state and federal assistance
- Helps businesses with workforce training and development needs

RETAINING YORK COUNTY BUSINESSES

The majority of commercial growth comes from existing industry. OED staff conducts industry visits, as well as a biennial Business Retention Survey, to help gauge the current business climate in the County. Among its many services to existing businesses, the OED:

- Assists with local, state and federal permitting and regulatory requirements
- Offers grant and incentive award programs
- Provides current demographic, consumer spending and traffic data
- Helps with workforce training and development
- Offers networking opportunities and educational workshops

SUPPORTING AN ENTREPRENEURIAL ENVIRONMENT

To build innovative new business development in York County, the OED:

- Partners with local businesses on education and training initiatives
- Ensures that licensing/permitting procedures are business-friendly
